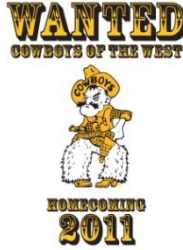


## PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS



### *Wanted – Cowboys of the West*

**2011 HOMECOMING PARADE – 10:00 a.m. start – 8:45 a.m. lineup  
Saturday, October 15, 2011**

*Entries participating in the 2011 UW Homecoming Parade will enter from 15<sup>th</sup> Street onto Iverson Avenue. **Parade check-in will be on 15<sup>th</sup> and Iverson.** City police will be blocking off side streets; this route will provide the only open access to the lineup location.*

*A Wyoming Student Alumni Association (WyoSAA) member will call your chairperson several days prior to the parade to provide you with your specific check-in time. WyoSAA representatives will direct you to your correct lineup position upon arrival.*

**Thanks for participating in the 2011 Homecoming Parade!** We hope you enjoy this great UW tradition. Here are some rules and regulations to help you with the process:

- 1) Organizations wishing to participate must file the attached forms, complete with the contact person's name and cell phone number, an entry description, and type of vehicle used, with the UW Alumni Association (corner of 14<sup>th</sup> and Grand Ave), 214 S. 14<sup>th</sup> St, Laramie, WY 82070, by **4:00 p.m. on Friday, October 7.** **A signed copy of the *Agreement to Parade Rules* must accompany the parade entry form.**
- 2) Parade entries must be the work of the organization(s) and not the work of a commercial firm. All floats must comply with the 2011 theme – *Wanted – Cowboys of the West*.
- 3) Cost of the entries must be kept below \$500. Each organization is on its honor to stay within this limit and will be responsible for paying for its own float.
- 4) Organizations must display their names on their floats. Entries carrying more than 20 individuals may be disqualified from judging at judges' request.
- 5) All floats must be able to travel the entire distance of the parade route, clear all obstructions, and be capable of turning 90-degree corners. Floats obstructing parade progress will be disqualified and must be immediately removed from the parade route.
- 6) Parade participants must conduct themselves in an appropriate public manner and comply with all applicable university, local, and state regulations. These regulations may be enforced by the appropriate agencies. Any violations may result in immediate disqualification from the parade and immediate removal of your entry from the parade route.

- 7) Marching units competing in either the campus or off-campus divisions must stay in formation along the parade route and perform a uniform drill/routine. They will be judged on execution of drill/routine, spirit, and costuming. Distributing leaflets or other materials and straying from formation along the parade route are prohibited.
- 8) Alcohol use or noticeable alcohol intoxication at any time during lineup or during the parade will result in immediate disqualification and immediate removal of your entry from the parade.
- 9) WyoSAA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify and require immediate removal of an entry from the parade when WyoSAA determines that an organization has not complied with parade rules and regulations. Noncompliance may also result in your organization being suspended from participating in future Homecoming parades.

**Note: WyoSAA welcomes participation in the Homecoming Parade by candidates running for political office. Due to the numbers of candidates however, we ask that they participate through the organized political party floats or campus political club floats. We must ask that all candidates remain on/in their parade transportation rather than walking the route. Currently serving state (5) and national (3) elected officials are invited to ride in the parade in transportation provided by WyoSAA.**

Keep a copy for your organization's information. **ORGANIZATIONS THAT HAVE NOT RETURNED A SIGNED AGREEMENT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PARADE.** Thank you for your participation!

If your organization receives a trophy for the 2011 Homecoming Parade, you are responsible for that trophy for one year. These traveling trophies must be made available for pick up by a WyoSAA representative by **September 5, 2012**. **If the trophy becomes misplaced or lost, the organization that was awarded the trophy will be held financially responsible.** Cost of trophies can exceed \$250.
